<u>Grand View University Choir Tour</u> The Grand View University Choir will be performing at Zion Evangelical Lutheran Church at 4 pm on Sunday, March 17. A reception follows the performance. Ash Wednesday + Lenten Services Christians gather on Ash Wednesday to mark the beginning of the Lenten season's preparation for Easter. On this day people receive an ashen cross on the forehead (a gesture received in baptism), hear God's promise of forgiveness, and taste God's mercy in the Holy Meal. The day's sermon is from John 5, "Do you want to be made well?" All are welcome. Worship at noon and 7:00 p.m. On March 13th, Midweek Lenten Worship begins at 7:15 PM with Holden Evening Prayer. Bible study and discussion groups will meet from 6:30 until 7:15. Our traditional soup suppers precede the evening's events, beginning at 6 pm.

<u>God's Word</u> On Sunday, March 10, we celebrate God's Word coming among us. All the Sunday School classes will explore how "the Word of the Lord came to Jonah." In our worship, Bibles will be presented to second graders.
